MOUNT PLEASANT RECREATION RESERVE MASTER PLAN

The draft Mount Pleasant Recreation Reserve Master Plan aims to reflect the wishes of the community and support their ideas for the site. Thanks to the 50 Mount Pleasant residents who shared their ideas for the draft Plan at the local community engagement session on 6 September 2016.

The Mount Pleasant Recreation Master Plan includes:

- Construction of a BBQ and Shelter
- Relocation of play space equipment
- Upgrade of public toilets
- Installation of park furniture, bins and a water fountain
- Renovation of steps
- Improved car parking and pathway connections to the Reserve
- Tree planting and signage

MOUNT PLEASANT KINDERGARTEN

The Mount Pleasant Kindergarten Upgrade will deliver a new 33-place kindergarten room for three- and four-year-old kindergarten programs, as well as providing space for local activities including playgroup and community meetings.

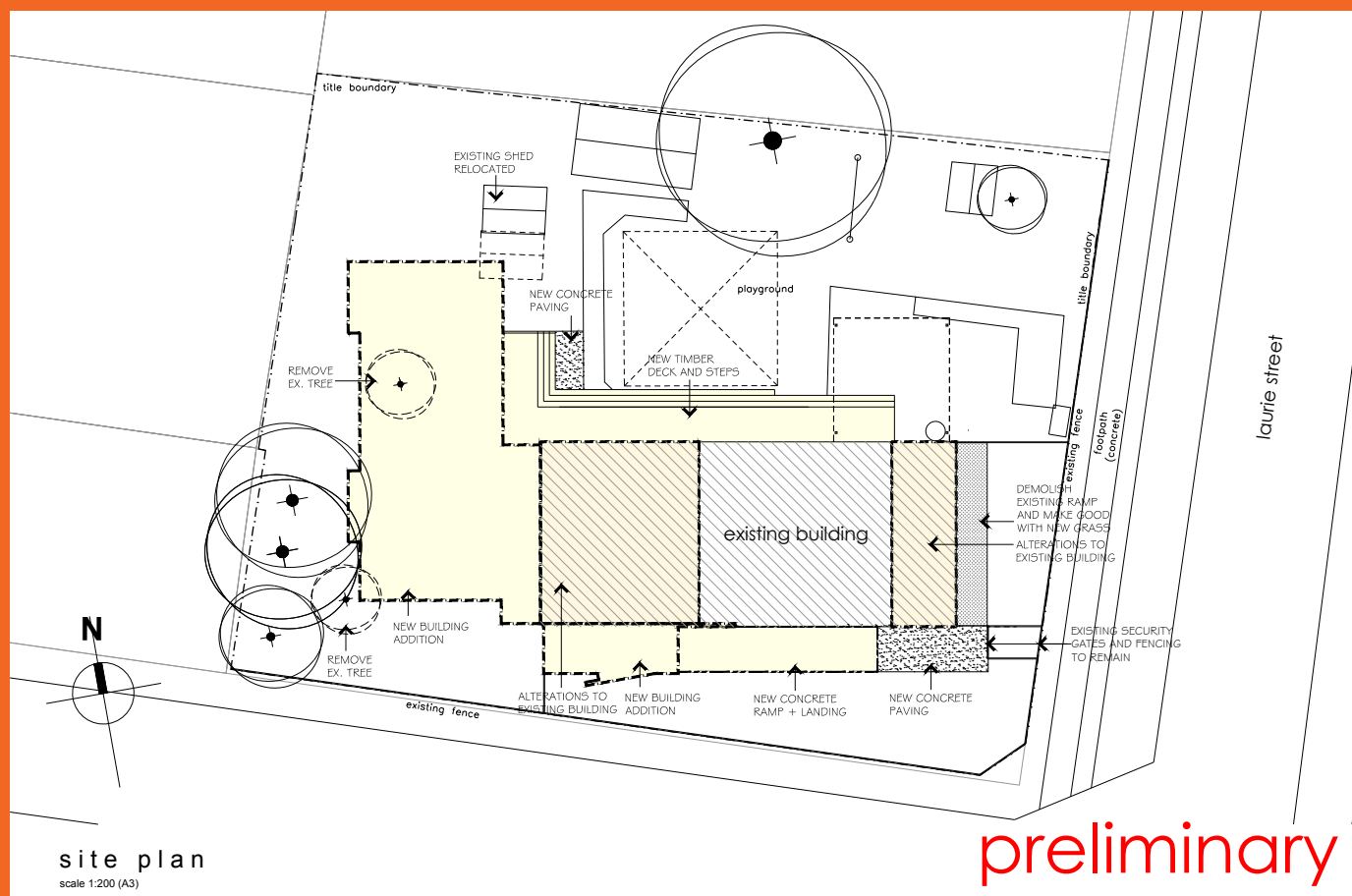
The redeveloped Mount Pleasant Kindergarten includes:

- New 33-place kindergarten room
- New entrance foyer
- Upgraded bathroom and kitchen facilities
- New external decking to the play space



The \$750,000 Mount Pleasant Kindergarten Upgrade is fully funded by the Victorian Government, and will be delivered by the City of Ballarat. Ballarat-based company Morton Dunn Architects are designing the facility upgrade.

Construction of the Mount Pleasant Kindergarten Upgrade is scheduled to begin late 2017, with completion expected by mid-2018.
